The term '**Safeguarding**' describes a preventative measure to keep all children safe. It ensures children do not suffer significant harm

Safeguarding Includes:

- Ensuring children grow up in a safe environment
- Taking action to ensure all children have the best outcomes
- Ensuring children's mental and physical health are looked after
- Protecting children from anything that might harm them
